

GRADUATE COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
February 14, 2006

The motion that was tabled at the Feb. 7 meeting was again brought up for discussion. It concerned the number of credit hours that a student who has completed one graduate degree at Marietta College could use toward a second graduate degree. After discussion the following motion was made and seconded and passed:

If a student has a graduate degree from Marietta College, courses used to satisfy requirements for that degree are NOT eligible to be transferred for use toward a second graduate degree at Marietta College. Any hours above and beyond the first degree can be transferred.

It was agreed that Cathy Brown would write the catalogue copy.

A discussion was held related to applications for funding by students to attend conferences and to sometimes present papers at those conferences. It was agreed that deadlines should be set in the future for fund applications for such trips. The Council approved a \$500 travel stipend for student Nathan Misel.

A new course, PSYC 610: Attachment and Family Relations was approved by the Council for inclusion in the Psychology Masters program.

The Council also approved the addition of EDU 660: Best Practices to the Education Masters core.
